At the October meeting, Scott Carmichael from Battels True Value Hardware in Whittier came to our meeting and talked about the recent changes at the store. Mr. Battel opened Battel's Hardware in 1943. Scott's father and grandfather bought it from him in 1958. Scott's father told us about this at a WOW meeting 7 years ago.

They were the largest Shopsmith dealer in the nation, selling many at the Los Angeles County Fair. They sold many woodworking tools to our members including Dave Reid who said he bought his Rockwell Unisaw there 33 years ago and has bought many tools since. Scott said his family appreciates WOW members support through the years.

In 1977 Scott's father brought him into the store to repair machinery. When he started he knew nothing about it, but learned through doing. The store sold tools on consignment and many had to be refurbished.

There have been many changes in the past year with a new owner. All the tools they were known for in the woodworking community were deleted. Things were not the same and the store was not doing well.

Scott and a partner bought the company recently and are in the process of bringing the store back up to snuff. They have tools on consignment again and they are bringing in power tools. As time goes on they are expanding departments such as paint and fasteners. They even have dust collection fittings and a sharpening service

I went in there the other day and they have an excellent plumbing department. Home Depot got rid of faucet repair kits, Battel's has hundreds. Scott says if they don't have it, they can find it.

I found latches and hinges for a box I made. Home Depot and Lowe's have a limited selection. Battel's has a huge selection of fasteners. The same helpful guys are there too. With Orchard Supply coming back to Whittier, Battel's is counting on their customer service, knowledgeable staff and hardware selection to keep customers coming to their store.
