## Special Note from the Toy Project Committee

The club distributed over 1,000 cars in 2023. To the members who worked throughout this last year making the cars we would like to thank you for all of your hard work.

Looking forward to 2024 we would like to offer a few simple reminders regarding the cars in order to continue to hand out quality hand made cars to each of our charities. We would like to mention a few things to look out for. Please make sure the cars are made for either a 2x4 or 2x6 piece of wood and make sure there are no knots. Please make sure all sharp edges are broken or rounded and each car is sanded. If you are making cars with windows cut all the way through please make sure the inside of the windows are sanded as well. No small parts can be glued to the cars, and they should not be painted or clear coated in any way. Finally please make sure when you are drilling the holes for the axles make sure to drill the holes all the way through using a 7/32" size drill bit. We have some templates available for a few different styles of cars. Contact Paul Wilson if you would like them sent to you.

All of your hard work is greatly appreciated and makes the club's toy project a huge success. Thank You again for all of your hard work and we look forward to another great year for the club in 2024.
