Steering Committee Minutes: August 15, 2023

**7:00 pm: Meeting called to order** – Minutes approved.

Finances (Arie K.): July ending bank balance \$3,402.69.

**Membership (Steve R.)**: There are 34 paid club members and two compensated members. July meeting attendance was 23 members and 3 guests. 8 new members so far this year.

**Toy project (Dick T.):** Cars inventory = Approx 1000 cars in inventory - some without wheels and axles. The quantity of blocks has not changed since last month. The anticipated amount to be given away in 2023 are completed. 80% of blocks expected to be needed in 2024 are completed.

**Raffle Project Update:** The last meeting resulted in \$68 in tickets sold against expenses of \$17.79. YTD totals are \$464 in sales and \$188.76 in Expenses. YTD \$165.11 has been earmarked for the Christmas party fund.

#### **New Business:**

- Discussion about the Hathaway schedule. No specific changes are necessary at this point.
- Discussion about labeling cars instead of branding them. Aerie provided samples of both, and the committee decided to proceed with labeling all cars beginning at the first opportunity to do so.
- Discussion, vote, and approval to a small club expense to buy small yard signs to be used to promote any future yard sales that the club participates in.
- Discussion about the method to price the cheerleader box project for Whittier High School. Agreed to further discussions at a later date.
- Discussion, vote, and approval to ask Steve Lelewer to engrave any new club badges needed going forward.

**Upcoming Meeting Schedules:** The next general club meeting will be September 14, and the next steering committee meeting will be held September 19 at the Whittier community center.
