WOW's was founded to make toys to be given to disadvantaged kids at Christmas time. So there is a lot of emphasis on this.. In addition, we are here to enable woodworkers to help woodworkers. Here is a rundown on what WOW does during the year--

Steering Committee Meeting is the Tuesday following the regular meeting. We meet at the Whittier Senior Center, 13325 Walnut St at 7 pm. All members are welcome to attend.

Open shops-- Like an open house, a member will invite other members to tour their shop. This is usually on a Saturday morning. It will be announced at a meeting before hand.

Hathaway Ranch block building project--is an ongoing project to build toy blocks to give away to children at Christmas time. It has been going for 17 years. Monday mornings 8:30 - noon at Hathaway Ranch, 11901 Florence Avenue, between Norwalk Boulevard and Pioneer Boulevard. Open the gate and drive in, close gate. In November we have a Wheels and Axels meeting. Members bring the toy cars they have made at home during the year. WOW provides the wheels and axels. At this meeting the wheels are attached using glue and hammers.

Early December there is Bagging Day. This is in the morning at the Hathaway Ranch, where all the toys and blocks made during the year are bagged up and distributed to the different charities.

In December we have a potluck dinner. This is instead of the regular meeting. Each member is encouraged to bring someone and a couple items they have made of wood to be given away through a raffle. 60 people attended last year and everyone got at least one prize.
